PCNS 1000th Meeting Commemorative Medal

PCNS issued an official commemorative medal to celebrate its 1000th regular meeting, held in July 1999. This spectacular octagonal medal was featured in *The Numismatist* (Nov. 1999). It bears the likeness of the famous numismatist and PCNS founder, Farran Zerbe. The PCNS official seal fills the reverse.

The Medallic Art Company struck 200 in silver and 200 in antiqued copper. (A few gold were produced on a pre-paid order basis only.) The silver is shown for the obverse, left above, and an antiqued copper specimen for the reverse, at right. The designs are identical in all three metals.

The silver medals are sold out, and the gold were never available after the 1000^{th} meeting. This medal will not be restruck. A limited quantity of the antiqued copper are still available.

Price: \$10, plus \$2 shipping, per copper specimen while supply lasts.

Dimens. Octagonal, 40mm edge to edge, 42.5mm point to point Weights Silver 31.0 grams (1.09+ ounces); Copper 29.2 grams
